BS Environmental Engineering Degree Program

The Dept. of Civil & Environmental Engineering would like to offer a new BS program in Environmental Engineering. This would replace the currently offered BS Civil Engineering: Environmental Engineering named option. CEE would like to be able to offer this degree program starting Fall 2021.

Most students would transfer from Civil Engineering; no need for additional resources to offer program.

Motion to recommend approval of the proposed BS Environmental Engineering as well as to suspend admission to the Environmental Engineering named option program passed unanimously.
